If you are interested in human rights issues and want to learn how the rule of law can help restore order and justice to this war-torn world, consider joining the World Peace Through Law Section of the State Bar.

Monthly meetings are at the Bar offices in Phoenix and Tucson, where lively discussions take place on current events. The annual convention and midyear CLEs are planned, along with original research, writing and oral presentations.

Some of the topics that have been explored in the last 14 years of this section are the International Court of Justice, U.S. intervention in Central America, the legal rights of refugees, legal reform in Vietnam, the International Criminal Court, human rights issues with NAFTA, the Persian Gulf crisis, the Law of War and the Geneva Conventions, elections in the Balkans, and elections in South Africa after the fall of apartheid.

The WPTL Section also has participated in peace fairs; spoken to local civic organizations; published articles in ARIZONA

ATTORNEY and the Arizona Institute for Peace, Education and Research; and presented resolutions to the Board of Governors. The Board approved the resolution directing the State Bar of Arizona to urge the U.S. Senate to ratify the U.N. Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women.

At the June 2002 annual convention, our seminar was the timely topic of War on Terror and the Surrender of Sovereignty. This year the topic will be the Crisis in the Middle East, with very important issues being analyzed—more than the average person gets from listening to sound bites on the evening news.
